These emerging new ideas and projects will then be evaluated as to their suitability for inclusion in the Proto-Incubator track in the WorldShift Leadership Circle event.

Successful ideas and projects are then assigned a Proto-Incubator slot in the event, and suitable experts and professionals will be selected to work together with you to co-create a next step and possibly a prototype design for you to take away and develop. The details of these tracks will remain confidential, though a brief summary of the work will be offered to those attending the event who indicate an interest in your area.

There are eleven hot topics which our most active members are engaged in. These form the core "tracks" over days 2 and 3 of the R2 WLC event. On day 1 of the event, we lead into these hot topic tracks with an overview of the 7 criteria R2 has developed for activities to be classified as "Second Renaissance" projects and programs, thereby qualifying as R2 projects. On each of the three days we also feature an inspiring keynote address, and end off with a big bang fiesta the last night.

**1. RETROFIT** – designing, building and retrofitting resilient habitats and transport systems in existing urban areas, including social housing

**2. MESHORG** - transitioning modern & post-modern organizations and networks into meshworks, including topics such as Holacracy and requisite organizations

**3. DEEPCOACH** - exploring the frontiers of 21st century coaching including approaches such as Integral Coaching

**4. TRANSLEAD** - moving beyond Integral Leadership to Transactivist Leadership which transcends and includes, transforms, interacts and activates change

**5. INTEGOV** - developing more integral systems of governance at local, regional, national and global levels

**6. GREENGROWTH** - rethinking economics and strategy/policy for prosperity through green growth

**7. BIORENEW** - reforestation, biofuels and other applications of cutting edge biology, nanotech and genomics

**8. GREENFUND** - developing new approaches to finance R2 projects including green financing mechanisms and alternative currency approaches

**9. DEEPCULTURE** - what is going on in the worlds of entertainment and education to shift our culture to a wiser way of being and doing?

**10. RENERG** - pushing the envelope in renewable energy systems, from smart grids to intelligent transport systems.

**11. WECOCREATE** - exploring the key ingredients for successful collaborative social systems and enterprises including the latest platforms, processes and practices

## HOW TO GET TO PERPIGNAN

### FLIGHT INFORMATION:

Perpignan airport is served by several direct flights a day from London (Ryanair), Paris (Airfrance), Manchester (Bmibaby), Birmingham and Southampton (Flybe), while nearby Girona airport (1 hr away) is served by 250 Ryanair flights a day.

Perpignan is also under two hours from **Barcelona** (Easyjet), **Toulouse**, **Montpellier** and **Carcassonne** airports.

For those flying to Girona airport, Spain, there is a new bus transfer service to Perpignan and back, the Frogbus. With 6 buses a day at €15 euros if reserved and paid on-line 24hrs in advance, this is an easy and quick (85 minutes) way to get to Perpignan if you don't feel like renting a car and don't want to spend a small fortune on a cab.

Take advantage of a 20% discount by using the discount code: **latourapollinaire** at the time you reserve your ticket online. For further details check out the website: <http://www.frogbus.com/en/> (Note, if you are not able to reserve on-line in advance, the ticket price is 20 euros cash only paid directly to the bus driver)

### TRAIN INFORMATION:

Trains run regularly to Perpignan station from Paris, Barcelona, London, Brussels, Italy, Switzerland and other parts of Europe, with the longer routes benefiting from high speed TGV trains.

Fast trains from Paris and Barcelona as well as other major European cities can be found at [www.sncf.fr](http://www.sncf.fr) Train times vary from a few hours from Barcelona to just over 4.5 hours to/from Paris. Both the airfares and train fares are very reasonably priced, particularly if you book ahead. The websites <http://www.voyages-sncf.com> and <http://www.tgv-europe.com> may also be helpful.

## **CAR RENTAL:**

Numerous car rentals options are available in Perpignan, There are dozens of great deals if you search around on the internet using Google to ask for 'low cost car rentals Perpignan'. Make sure in book in advance on the Internet to get a better deal. In case you fly to Spain (Barcelona or Girona) we recommend you hire your car there as it is cheaper in Spain than in France.

A word of advice to those arriving at the local airports - to avoid long queues at peak periods for your car, avoid booking with the car company which is offering a 'special deal' with your flight. And, while everyone else is waiting for their bags on the carousel at Perpignan airport, quickly pop out to the care hire desk of your choice to collect your keys and avoid any queuing at all. All major car hire companies are represented at Perpignan airport and station.
